Noise associated with the erection, demolition, alteration or repair of any building or other construction, reconstruction, or demolition activity other than between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on weekdays, or between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, except in the event that a finding of urgent necessity in the interest of public welfare or safety may be made by the Commissioner of Planning and Development who shall then issue a permit to allow such activity. Such permit may be requested for a period of three days or less while the emergency continues. Noise from construction and demolition activity in Industrial 2 (I-2) Districts is exempt from this section, and this section does not apply to activity in Industrial 2 (I-2) zones.

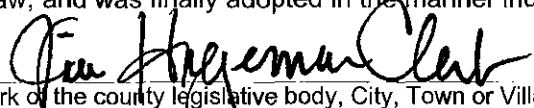

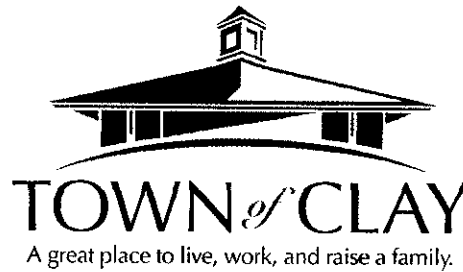
