TOWN OF CLAY, ONONDAGA COUNTY, NEW YORK**

**A LOCAL LAW TO CREATE A DEPUTY CLERK POSITION
TO THE TOWN COURT OF THE TOWN OF CLAY.**

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Clay, Onondaga County, New York, as follows:

SECTION 1.

Civil Service Law Section 41 (1)(d) states that one clerk and one deputy clerk if authorized by law, of each court shall be in the Exempt Class of the Civil Service Law.

SECTION 2.

The Town of Clay by this Local Law, authorizes the creation of the position of Deputy Clerk to the Town Court, which position shall be in the Exempt Class of the Civil Service Law.

SECTION 3. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the Secretary of State.

The purpose of this Local Law is to authorize the creation of the position of Deputy Clerk to the Town Court, which position shall be in the Exempt Class of the Civil Service Law.

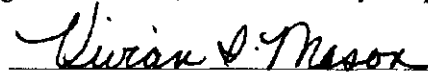

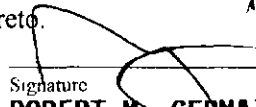
