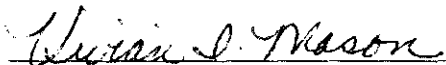

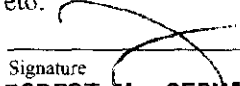

LOCAL LAW NO. 6 OF THE YEAR 2008 ABOLISHING THE CLAY POLICE DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 150(4) OF THE NYS TOWN LAW AND THE TRANSFER OF FUNCTION OF THE TOWN POLICE DEPARTMENT WITH THE ONONDAGA COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT AND FURTHER TO ENTER INTO A PROPOSED CONTRACT WITH ONONDAGA COUNTY FOR THE EXTENSION OF ADDITIONAL POLICE SERVICES WITHIN THE TOWN OF CLAY, TO THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF CLAY.

IT IS ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Clay, County of Onondaga, as follows:

SECTION 1. Abolishing the Town of Clay Police Department pursuant to Section 150(4) of New York State Law and to the transfer of function of the Town Police Department with the Onondaga County Sheriff's Department and further to enter into a proposed Contract with Onondaga County for the extension of additional police services within the Town of Clay to the Code of the Town of Clay. **THIS LOCAL LAW AND RESOLUTION WAS SUBJECT TO A PUBLIC REFERENDUM, AND WAS DULY APPROVED BY QUALIFIED VOTERS OF SAID TOWN OF CLAY VOTING AT THE SPECIAL ELECTION WHICH WAS DULY CALLED, HELD AND CONDUCTED ON JUNE 23RD, 2008.**

**LOCAL LAW NO. 6 OF THE YEAR 2008

The purpose of Local Law No. 6 of the Year 2008 is to abolish the Town of Clay Police Department, pursuant to Section 150(4) of NYS Town Law and to transfer the function of the Town of Clay Police Department to the Onondaga County Sheriff's Department and further to enter into a proposed contract with Onondaga County for the extension of additional police services within the Town of Clay.

Abolishing the Town of Clay Police Department pursuant to Section 150(4) of New York State Law and to the transfer of function of the Town Police Department with the Onondaga County Sheriff's Department and further to enter into a proposed Contract with Onondaga County for the extension of additional police services within the Town of Clay to the Code of the Town of Clay.

This Local Law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.
