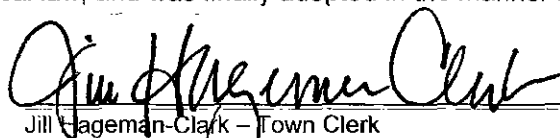

PROPOSED LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF THE YEAR 2023 to amend **CHAPTER 230** entitled “**ZONING**” by amending Section §230-22C. (1) (c) [1] [a] [i] adding the words “and Community Center” after religious institutions and to strike the word “and” before religious institutions to said section of the Code of the Town of Clay.

IT IS PROPOSED TO ENACT by the Town Board of the Town of Clay, County of Onondaga as follows:
