A local law AMENDING CHAPTER 125-A ENTITLED "ALTERNATIVE VETERANS EXEMPTION"

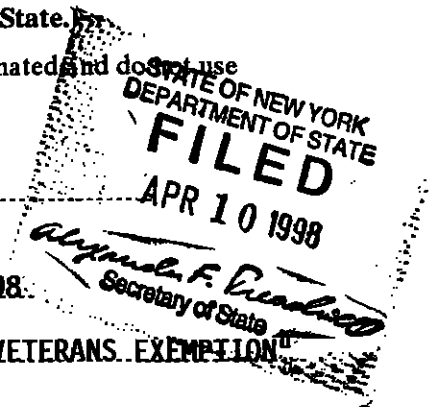

Amendment of Chapter 125-A entitled "Alternative Veterans Exemption", Section 125-A.4 Granting of Exemption, Subparagraphs 1, 2 and 3 to the Town of Clay Municipal Code.

The purpose of this local law is to increase the maximum exemption allowable to veterans as provided in paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) of subdivision 2 of Section 458-a of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York, with new limits of \$27,000.00, \$18,000.00 and \$90,000.00 respectively. Said Local Law is to read as follows:

§ 125-A.1 **Title**

This Chapter shall be known as the "**ALTERNATIVE VETERANS EXEMPTION LAW OF THE TOWN OF CLAY**".

§ 125-A.2 **Purpose**

The purpose of this local law is to increase the maximum exemption allowable to veterans as provided in paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) of subdivision 2 of Section 458-a of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York.

§ 125-A.3 **Definitions**

The meanings of words and expressions as used in this Chapter shall be identical to their meanings as used in Section 458-a of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York.

§ 125-A.4 **Granting of Exemption**

1. The maximum exemption allowable pursuant to paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of Section 458-a of the Real Property Tax Law is hereby increased to the sum of \$27,000.00;

2. The maximum exemption allowable pursuant to paragraph (b) of the Real Property Tax Law is hereby increased to the sum of \$18,000.00; and

3. The maximum exemption allowable pursuant to paragraph (c) of the Real Property Tax Law is hereby increased to the sum of \$90,000.00.

§ 125-A.5 **Application**

This local law shall apply to assessment rolls prepared on the basis of a taxable status date occurring on or after **January 1st, 1998**.

§ 125-A.6 **Effective Date**

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.

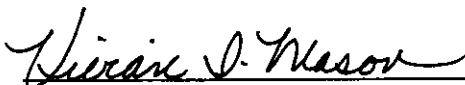

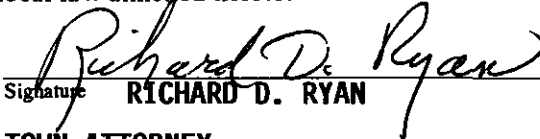
